



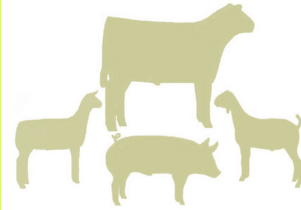
North Carolina 4-H Youth Livestock Agent & Volunteer Training

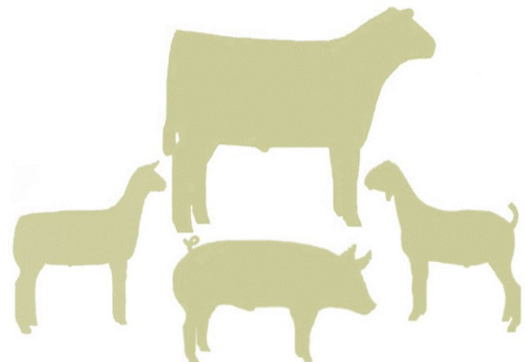
